

Sick Patient Care

Prescriptions and Refills


In general, prescriptions for medications are not called in without the patient being seen and examined first. Refill prescriptions for chronic medications (other than antibiotics) will be called in to a pharmacy within 24 hours.

Lab, X-ray and Test Results

All lab, x-ray, and test results will be discussed with the patient's family within a reasonable amount of time of arriving in our office, usually within 24 hours.

Appointments


